How to Resist Temptation

KEY IDEA:
“Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”



In any conflict it is wise to know your opponent. The Bible shows in *Ephesians* 6:12, that we as Christians are in battle against Satan and sin in the world. To gain spiritual victory, we must learn:

1. To recognize Satan at work and
2. How to resist him during temptation.
